15th August The Feast of The Assumption

The ways of God are not our ways. Mercifully, they are far more wonderful. There is another way of looking at things than the world's way. There is something else to be seen. Christ has been raised from the dead by the power of the Father's arm, exalting the lowly. And today the Risen One raises his mother's body and soul to the glory of heaven: sin conquered in her from the first moment of her existence, death conquered in her at the end of her earthly life. The world to all appearances goes on, the proud and the princes. But ever since Easter night, it has been undermined, fatally undermined, mortally wounded. Mary's Magnificat runs through history now like a hidden melody, audible only to the ears of faith, but unforgettable once heard and infinitely more resonant than the chatter of the world or the clatter of the Dragon and his falling stars. Our Lord could have left us only with the pledge of his own resurrection, Easter in April, hope of eternal life. But he has given us to the pledge of his mother's Assumption, Easter in August, additional hope of eternal life: the woman as well as the man, the handmaid as well as the Lord, the Church as well as the Christ, creation as well as Creator.
